#### LOTS TO DO AT DESTINY USA IN JANUARY!

The FM is at Destiny on Saturday, January 11 and Sunday, January 12, 2010 where we will meet the same place as last year, on the first floor of the Canyon area between Dick's on one side and Cantina Laredo on the other, just a little way in from the doors to the outside. If you park in one of the large parking lots on Solar Street and enter using the escalator up and across the pedestrian bridge over Hiawatha Blvd., you then need to go down to the first floor. There is an escalator nearby and an elevator a little farther along. Check out the new cars on display as you make your way to our tables. Besides getting your Annual Pass or Yearly Passport, be sure to vote for the new President of the Board of CNY Folksmarch and for some new Board members!

To walk the full 5k inside, you'll need to walk the perimeter of all 4 levels. We believe the mall will be able to provide a Passport of Savings booklet so you can take advantage of after Christmas sales, although most stores won't open until 10 am on Saturday. For those who want to go outside, since the area to the edge of the lake is still closed, we'll use the alternate outside Creek Walk route over the bridge on Hiawatha Boulevard and back towards the Inner Harbor.

## Directions

From the **north**, take Interstate 81 South to exit 23B (Destiny USA Dr.)

From the **south**, take Interstate 81 North to exit 23 (Hiawatha Blvd.)

From the **east**, take Interstate 690 West to I-81 North to exit 23 (Hiawatha Blvd.)

From the **west**, take Interstate 690 East to exit 8 (Hiawatha Blvd.)

New York State Thruway: take I-90 to exit 36 (I-81 South) and follow above directions from the north

## It's Time to Get Your Annual Pass or Yearly Passport

It's time to get your Annual Pass or Yearly Passport to start in January, 2020. The cost of the Annual Pass is \$40.00 for an individual and \$90.00 for a family (consisting of up to 2 adults and all children under 18 years of age). The Annual Pass provides two free walks and one yearly Passport. Or you can get a Yearly Passport for \$10 (pro-rated each quarter) in which you record your mileage and get a stamp of the walk; it is also the other way besides an Annual Pass to become a member of CNY FM. Remember also that if you want the Footnotes sent to you by US Mail, sign up in January for \$12.00 to get the 12 months – since this wasn't available at the December 2019 FM, we will mail out the January Footnotes to those on the 2019 list.

## About Us

Folksmarches are generally held on the second weekend every month. Registration is held between 8 am and 11 am on Saturdays, and from 1 to 3 pm on Sundays of the event. Participants walk at their own pace, and the purpose is strictly for fun, fellowship and exercise.

The route distances are a choice of either 5K (3.1 miles) or 10K (6.2 miles). Routes vary at each location, but normally include a combination of paved walkways and natural settings. Routes are marked and a map is provided to each walker. A shorter modified route is always available to those who choose not to walk the longer distances.

Participants receive a pin to commemorate the walk and passports are available (for a fee) for participants to record their personal accomplishment after each walk. Purchasing an Annual Pass or a Yearly Passport is a way to become a member of the CNY Folksmarch walking group.
