### Winter Walk at Great Northern Mall

Winter is still hanging on, so we'll be walking at the Great Northern Mall on Saturday and Sunday, March 13 & 14, 2021. The address is 4155 NY Rt. 31, Clay, NY 13041. Use one of the entrances at the back of the mall near the Movie Theaters - either on the right of the Theaters or the Mall Office entrance to the left of the Movie Theaters. The Great Northern Mall opened on October 5, 1988 with 80 stores, a food court, and a 10-screen Regal Cinemas multiplex. As with many other malls in Central New York, Great Northern has lost some of its stores over the last several years but is working towards a come-back. Because there is only one level, walking around the inside 4 times, or as many as you want, will be easy to do. Stopping to shop and snack, of course, may hold you up a bit! If the sun deigns to shine and the temperature warms up, one can always make 3 circuits around the outside of the mall.

Enter through the rear of the mall near the Movie Theaters on the right or the Mall Office entrances to the left of the Movie Theaters. We will be set up in the Food Court.

#### Directions

**From the North or South**, take Rt. 481 to Exit 12. If from the North, turn left onto Rt. 31 / if from the South, turn right onto Rt. 31, then left into the mall entrance where you see the Regal Cinemas 10 sign. Go to the rear of the mall near the Movie Theaters and enter using either the entrance on the right of the Theaters or the Mall Office entrance to the left of the Theaters.

**From the East or West**, follow Rt. 31 to the Regal Cinemas 10 sign to enter the mall and proceed to the rear where the entrances near the Theaters are located as stated above.
