Folksmarch Along Onondaga Lake

SEPTEMBER 10, 9:00 AM-NOON AND SEPTEMBER 11, 1:00 PM-3:00 PM

Our walk will begin at the Honeywell Onondaga Lake Visitor's Center adjacent to the Onondaga Lake Boat Launch. There is ample parking and restroom facilities are located within the center.

From the deck of the center there are good views of Syracuse, Destiny and Liverpool.

Years ago, the lake was highly polluted but thanks to the work done by Honeywell and major improvements of the Syracuse water treatment facility the lake is now clean enough for fishing. There is information in the visitor center about how the lake was cleaned up.

We will walk along a path that is part of the Erie Canalway Trail / Empire State Trail. The surface is nicely paved and level. It starts out kind of noisy due to traffic on I-690 but soon veers away from the road and is quite peaceful. When Elaine and I walked the route we saw geese, ducks, a bald eagle, and other birds that we didn't identify. There were abundant wildflowers along the way, there are 4 or 5 benches spaced along the route. The round-trip distance to the foot bridge is 2.8 miles, however you can continue over the bridge if you wish.



NOTE: COVID19 precautions:

We will practice social distancing and wear masks when necessary and have sanitizer available at the sign-in table. We will observe all County, local and facility rules for staying safe and healthy.

Directions

The Onondaga Lake Visitor's Center is easy to find. From Syracuse take I-690 West to Exit 7. (This is the exit for the Orange State Fair parking lot). At the light, take a right and the visitor center parking lot is just a very short distance on the lake shore.

From the west, take I-690 to the exit for NYS Fairgrounds Main Gate on State Fair Boulevard. Left on State Fair Blvd and the first left toward the entrance to the Orange State Fair parking lot. Go straight ahead at the light and the visitor center parking lot is just a very short distance on the lake shore.

(Please note: There is a sign at the parking lot entrance stating that parking is for boat launch and fishing only. All others will be towed. You can disregard this notice as it is intended to prevent State Fair goers from using this lot.)


