### May Folksmarch Among the Apple Trees

MAY 20, 9:00 AM-NOON AND MAY 21, 1:00 PM-3:00 PM –

**Critz Farms** opened in the mid 80's as a pumpkin farm with a cute play area for children. Since then, it has grown to an almost year-round destination with apples and cider, Christmas trees, maple syrup and many other goodies, besides a large playground with unique equipment for youngsters to enjoy. Families can easily spend an entire afternoon enjoying the farm or relaxing inside or on the patio of the Tasting Room.



Our May Folksmarch will include various levels of intensity that can appeal to just about everyone. If we get much rain the week prior, certain areas on the trails might be somewhat muddy. You may choose the easier Trillium Trail with a portion of the path along an old railroad bed. The more challenging Blue Loop is covered with leaves and several branches and other moderate challenges, including a couple of short, but slightly steep hills. A walking stick



would be helpful in a few spots. It's also very possible to create your own route, taking in the view from the hill near the Tasting Room, then down and around the animal barns and the play area.

We hope you join us at the May Folksmarch and bring the kids or the grandkids, friends and neighbors. Your "well behaved, leashed dogs" are also welcome everywhere on the farm.

Our sign-in table will be in the Tasting Room. As usual, follow the Folksmarch arrows and look for the Folksmarch banner and sign. After your walk you may want to relax inside, or on the patio, sipping a beverage that has been produced from ingredients grown right on the farm. A special treat might be a root beer float made with maple syrup produced on the farm.

Our gracious hostess, and owner, Juanita Critz has made arrangements to have Oscar's Food Truck available on both days. Saturday from Noon-8:00 and Sunday from 11:00-6:00. Fingers crossed for pleasant weather to thoroughly enjoy this lovely location for our monthly walk.

### Directions

*From North (Baldwinsville):* Rte 690E to 481S to Exit 3E; Follow Rte 92 through Manlius to end; turn left on Rte 20; turn right on Rte 13; Critz Farms will be 3.5 miles on the left.

*From the South (Preble):* Rte 81N to Tully exit; turn left off ramp to Rte 80; turn right on Rte 80E; Follow Rte 80 through Fabius; turn left at flashing light onto Rte 13 N; Critz Farms will be 3.5 miles on the right.

*From the East (Syracuse):* Rte 90 to Canastota; turn left off ramp and follow Rte 13S; turn right on Rte 13S (Rte 5W); Follow Rte 13S (Rte 5W) through Chittenango; Fork left in Chittenango to stay on Rte 13S; Continue South past Chittenango Falls to Cazenovia; Rte 13S turns right and then left in Cazenovia; Stay straight on Rte 13; Critz Farms will be 3.5 miles on the left.

*From the West (Skaneateles):* Rte 20E to Cazenovia; turn right onto Rte 13S; Critz Farms will be 3.5 miles on the left.

*Please note: Anyone who is not using GPS or another navigation system, please do not rely totally on these directions. Double check on a map or whatever you usually use when travelling.*

## Highlights: Summer in April at Jordan-Elbridge

Very warm sunny summery weather on both Saturday and Sunday greeted the walkers at the Jordan-Elbridge Community Center for the walk along the canal. Many walkers stopped at Lock 51 where the Village of Jordan Historian, Elaine Peters, and her helpers dressed in period clothes, provided details on the history of the period. The Enlarged Lock 51 was built in 1857 and was “a busy thoroughfare with traffic jams, schedules to meet, and lock gates clanging shut” [from the interpretive sign at the website] until the construction of the State Barge Canal in 1918. Elaine even generously provided water to many walkers who needed it after their sun-drenched walk!
