A restored farmhouse will be our sign-in location for the June Folksmarch at the Great Swamp Conservancy in Canastota. This year GSC is celebrating its 26th anniversary and continues to display natural surroundings during all four seasons. The staff maintains seven

miles of trails that go through fields, beaver ponds, forested lands and flooded wooded swamps. *Boots are generally the thing to wear when visiting this site.* Our Folksmarch this month will most likely be along the Heron Overlook Trail where the blue herons and their babies are nesting this time of year before going out on their own, probably in July. There are also other trails and opportunities to enjoy nature at the conservancy. Well-behaved leashed dogs are allowed on most (but not all) of the trails. Please bring your own clean-up bags.

Directions

From Syracuse (easiest route): Take I-90 (Thruway) to Exit 34 for NY-13 toward Canastota/Oneida; turn right onto NY-13N; turn left onto Warners Rd.; turn left onto Pine Ridge Rd.; turn right onto N. Main St. Destination will be on the left.

From points North and West of Syracuse: Head east on NY-31E (Lake Rd.); Continue through Bridgeport into Madison County and Lakeport. Turn right on N. Main St. Destination will be on the right.

From points South and East of Syracuse: Take NY-173E; Turn right onto Tag Rd.; turn left onto Gee Rd.; turn right onto Pine Ridge Rd and left onto N. Main St. Destination will be on the left.

ATTENTION:

(1) PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THE THRUWAY BRIDGE AT THE CANASTOTA EXIT MAY BE CLOSED AND ARROWS WILL DIRECT YOU INTO THE VILLAGE. WATCH FOR THE SIGNS.

(2) ON SUNDAY FROM NOON-2:30 THE BOXING HALL OF FAME PARADE WILL BE ON PETERBORO ST. IN CANASTOTA. IT SHOULDN'T AFFECT YOUR DRIVING ROUTE, BUT THERE MIGHT BE MORE TRAFFIC THAN USUAL IN THE VILLAGE.

Please note: Anyone who is not using GPS or another navigation system, please do not rely totally on these directions. Double check on a map or whatever you usually use when travelling.
