A folksmarch is a non-competitive walking event conducted monthly for people of all ages and abilities in Central New York.



September Folksmarch: Reed Webster Park & Empire State Trail

SEPTEMBER 9, 9:00 AM-NOON AND SEPTEMBER 10, 1:00 PM-3:00 PM – Reed Webster Park in Camillus.

The sign-in location for this month's Folksmarch will be at the pavilion in Reed Webster Park in Camillus. It's a short walk to the starting point of one of the newer sections of the Empire State Trail/Erie Canalway Trail. The paved trail begins with a slight uphill slope heading east, but soon levels off. This might not be the most scenic section of the Empire/Erie trail, but along the way you may spot some wild turkeys or other little critters and birds. Some walkers claim there's a desert feel along a portion of the trail, but upon turning a bend you quickly realize you are not far from a suburban neighborhood. A marker will indicate when Folksmarchers have reached the 1.5-mile turn-around point. With the walk back that equals just about a 5k. For any who want a much greater challenge, they can continue along this section of the trail to the New York State Fairgrounds which is about 3.5 miles from our starting point (and of course, back again to Reed Webster would be a total of 7 miles.)

FYI: Leashed dogs are allowed on the trail but are NOT allowed in Reed Webster Park.

From Syracuse: Take I-690W to Exit 6 (NY-695S to NY-173W/Warners Rd.) Take NY-173/Warners Rd. Exit from NY-5W. Follow NY-173W/Warners Rd. for 1.4 miles. Destination (Reed Webster pavilion and parking lot) will be on your right.
