**From the North:** take Route 81 to Clinton St. exit. Turn left on Fayette St. Turn right onto Montgomery St.

**From the South:** take Route 81 to Adams St. exit. Travel north on Almond St. Turn left on Fayette St. and left on Montgomery St.

**From the East:** take Route 690 to Townsend St. exit. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go to the 4<sup>th</sup> light and turn right on Fayette St. Go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> light and turn left on Montgomery St.

**From the West:** take Route 690 to the West St. exit. At the first light after the off ramp turn left onto Fayette St. Go to the 5<sup>th</sup> light and turn right onto Montgomery St.
