FEBRUARY FOLKSMARCH IN THE VILLAGE OF MINOA

Let's hope this unusually mild winter is the case on the second weekend in February when we will be walking the village streets of Minoa. Jamie, the very accommodating owner of **Northbound Mind & Body Shop** has agreed to open her store during off hours for Folksmarchers to sign-in at the shop which is located at **116 North Main St., Minoa, NY 13166.**



The 5k +/- route we have planned will take Folksmarchers through the residential streets of Minoa, which is the smallest of the 3 villages in the Town of Manlius. It was once a prominent railroad community and was known as Manlius Station – a stop on the Syracuse/Utica Railroad line. Nowadays, this quaint historic neighborhood, with a population of about 3500, has seen some growth with several new retailers joining the business district. **Leashed dogs are allowed on the walking route, but not inside the businesses.**



Our Folksmarch ends back at the Northbound shop and right across the street from **Trappers II Pizza & Pub** where you can grab lunch, a snack, dinner or a beverage on Saturday or Sunday after Noon. According to Jen, the owner of Trappers II, their slogan says they have: "food and fun for everyone." And good pizza!



DIRECTIONS

- * from Syracuse: Route 481 N to Exit 5E (Kirkville Rd.) Turn right on Fremont Rd.; Turn left on Central Ave. Go all the way to the end; Turn left on N. Main St.
- * Free parking on the street and in the municipal lot next to the Post Office on your left.

About Us

Folksmarches are generally held on the second weekend every month. Registration is held between 9 AM and 12 PM on Saturdays, and from 1 to 3 PM on Sundays of the event. Participants walk at their own pace, and the purpose is strictly for fun, fellowship, and exercise.

The route distance is typically 5K (3.1 miles). Routes vary at each location, but normally include a combination of paved walkways and natural settings. Routes are marked and a map is provided to each walker. A shorter modified route is always available to those who choose not to walk the longer distances.

Participants receive a button to commemorate the walk and yearly passport cards are available (for a fee) for participants to record their personal accomplishment after each walk. Purchasing an Annual Membership Pass or a Yearly Passport card is a way to become a member of the CNY Folksmarch walking group.
