AUGUST FOLKSMARCH AT CEDAR BAY PARK, TOWN OF DEWITT A/K/A OLD ERIE CANAL STATE HISTORIC PARK


We were all wearing masks and keeping a safe distance apart the last time we had a Folksmarch at Cedar Bay Park. That was in October 2020. We will walk a similar route this time. Our 5k Folksmarch will include the paved surface along the canal from the park going east toward North Burdick St., with an option to go further if desired.



Also included will be a portion of Ryder Park that consists of trails composed of crushed stone and wood chips. Both areas have level terrain. Leashed dogs are allowed with owners doing any needed clean-up, of course.

The walk along the Erie Canal is a pleasant, not difficult walk. If it is a sunny day you will want to bring sunscreen and/or a hat, as there is very little shade along this section of the canal.


Our sign-in table will be at the pavilion which is clearly visible from the parking lot.



DIRECTIONS:

The park does not have an actual address, but 6975 Cedar Bay Rd., Fayetteville NY seems to work for GPS. The entrance to the park is located between Kinne Rd. and North Burdick St.

From Syracuse: Take Route 5E (a/k/a Erie Blvd East), turn left onto Kinne Rd. (just before Shoppingtown) and follow to the T at the end. Turn left onto Lyndon Rd which becomes Cedar Bay Rd. Travel about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; turn left into the parking lot of Cedar Bay Park/Old Erie Canal State Historic Park.

About Us

Folksmarches are generally held on the second weekend every month. The route distance is typically 5K (3.1 miles). Routes vary at each location, but normally include a combination of paved walkways and natural settings. Routes are marked and a map is provided to each walker. A shorter modified route is always available to those who choose not to walk the longer distances. Participants receive a button to commemorate the walk and yearly passport cards are available (for a fee) for participants to record their personal accomplishment after each walk. Purchasing an Annual Membership Pass or a Yearly Passport card is a way to become a member of the CNY Folksmarch walking group.
